Greetings from the RKS Fraternity!

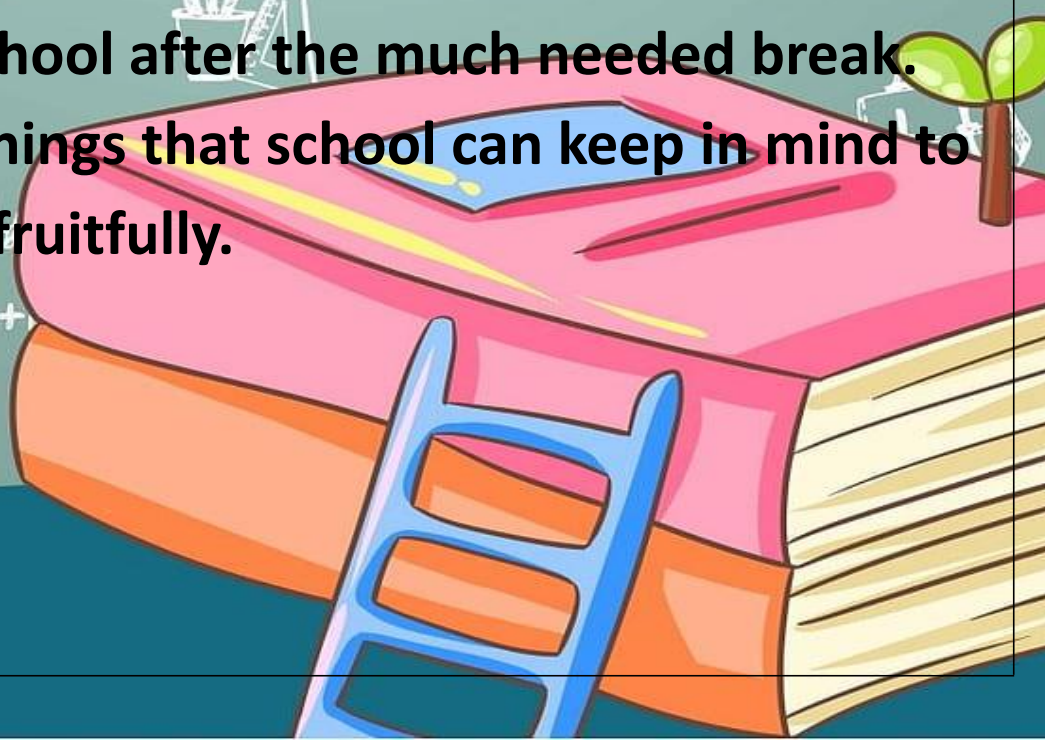

General Instructions:-

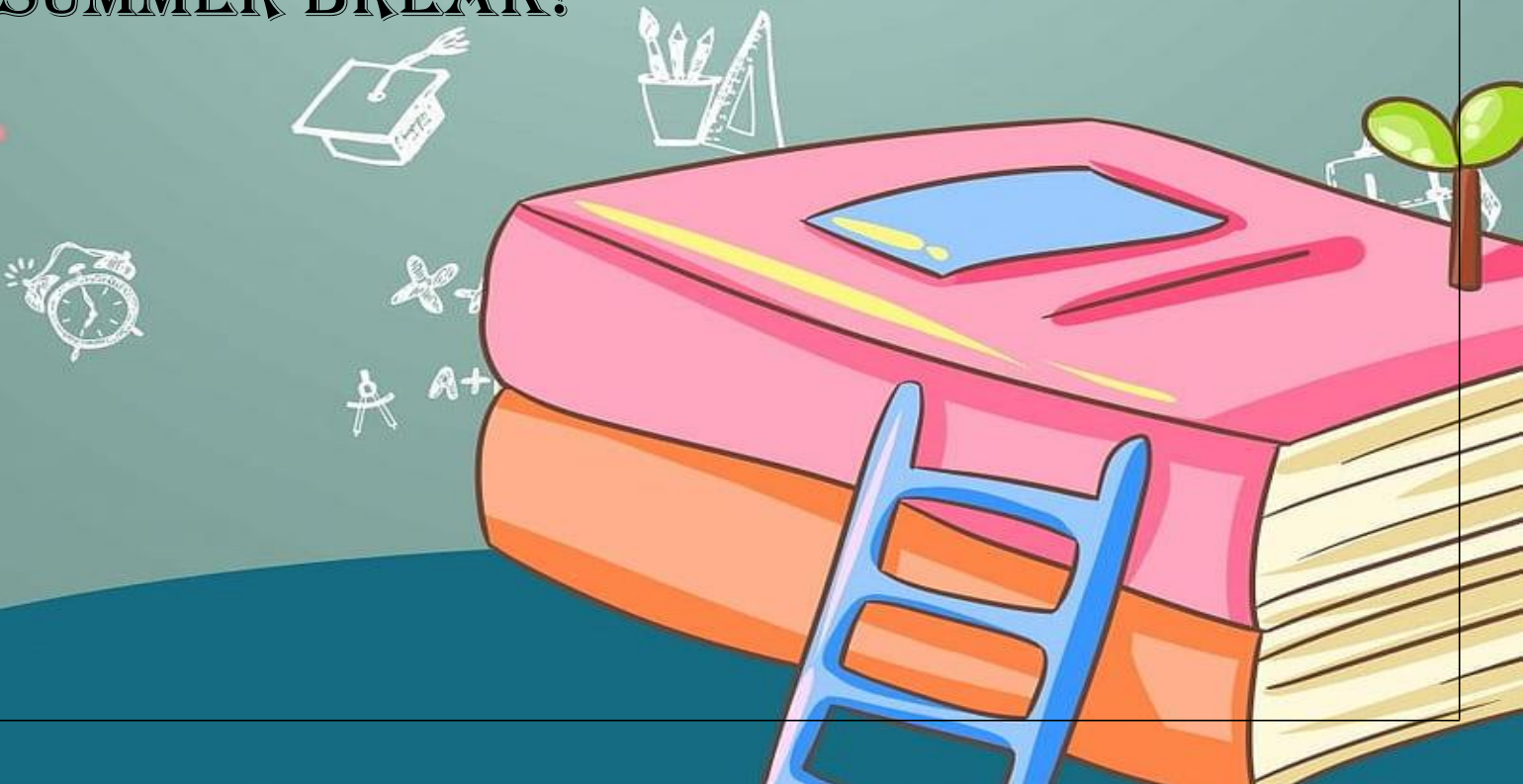
- **Revise the syllabus covered so far in the class to prepare for Periodic Tests, which will be held in the month of July.**

Do 1 page of writing daily in your rough notebook.

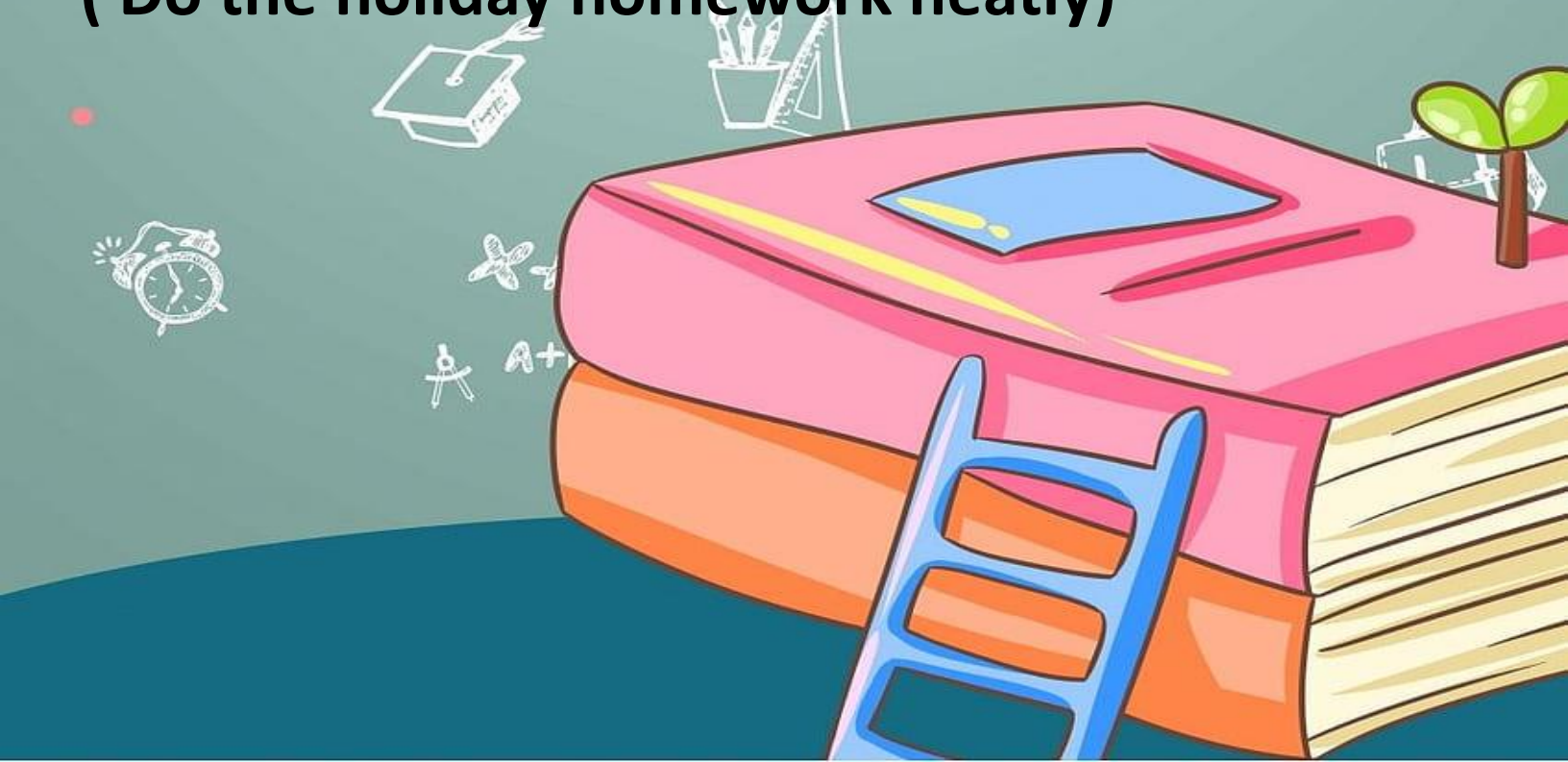
Do Comprehension passage given on pg no. 119 in Grammar book

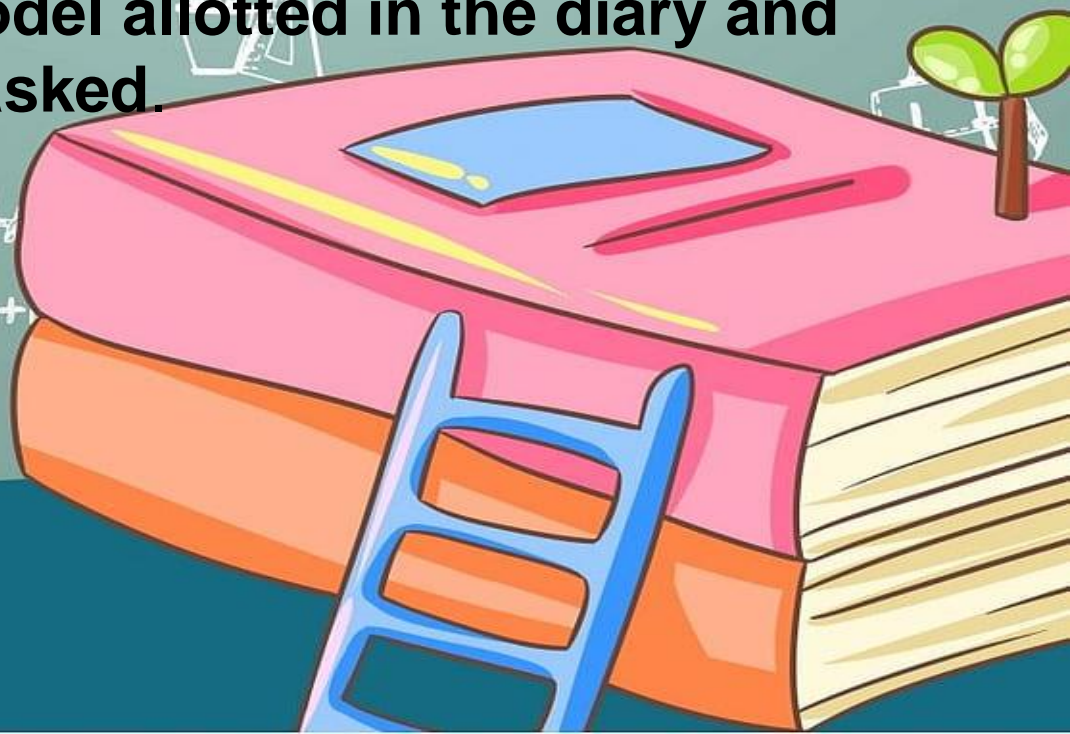
