Instructions:

Read the novel carefully during the summer vacation. A group discussion will be conducted after the break as part of your internal assessment. You are expected to express your views, share insights, and reflect on Helen Keller's journey based on your reading.

Group Discussion Question

"How does Helen Keller's autobiography *The Story of My Life* inspire us to overcome challenges, and what role do determination, education, and support play in shaping her journey?"

Q5) Project: The Caged vs. The Wild – A Tiger's Tale(Poem- A Tiger in the Zoo

i. Poem Analysis

- Explain the central theme of the poem in 80-100 words.
- Highlight key literary devices (e.g., metaphors, personification, contrast).
- Compare the tiger's behavior in the zoo vs. in the wild as described in the poem.

ii. Poster or Collage

- Create a visual comparison showing a caged tiger and a tiger in the wild.
- Use drawings or collage materials.
- Include short lines or phrases from the poem to label each side.

iii. Research Element

- Write a short note on why tigers are endangered.
- Explain how wildlife conservation efforts help protect them.
- Mention laws in India that help protect wild animals (e.g., Wildlife Protection Act, 1972).

iv. Creative Writing

- Write a diary entry from the perspective of the caged tiger.(100-120 words)
 - Express the tiger's feelings about confinement and longing for freedom.
- Note: i) Use A-4 size sheets and submit the project in a proper folder.

ii) The project must include a cover page with title of the project.
