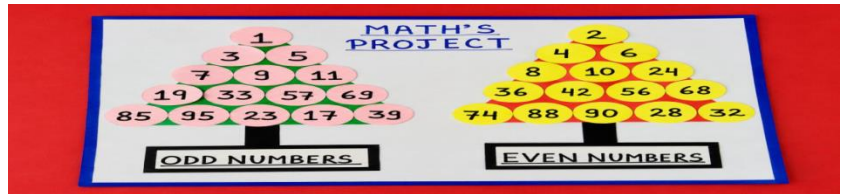

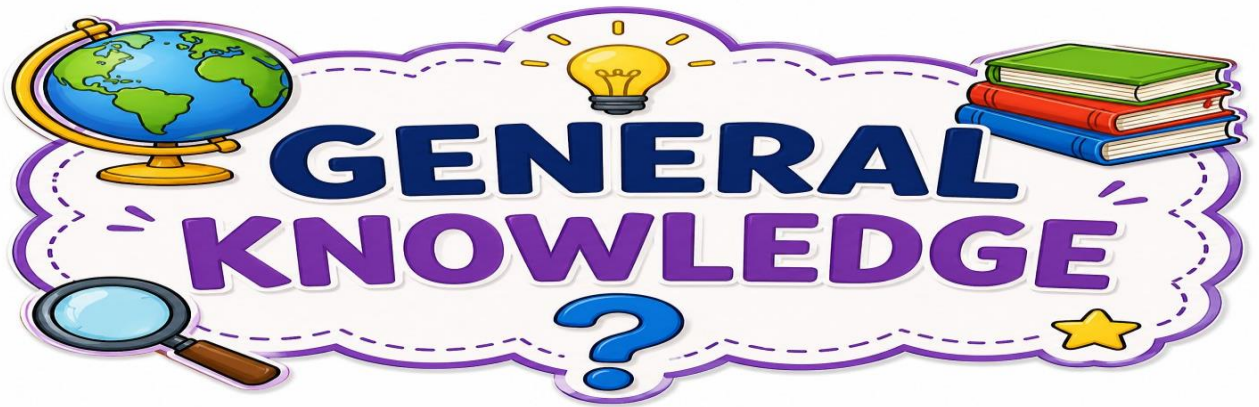


1. Do the attached worksheet of addition and subtraction given at the end of the holiday homework and paste it in the copy.
